

Every breath you take..... A Citizen Science project measuring air quality in Manchester

2nd September 2015

On Saturday 31st January, Manchester Friends of the Earth hosted the How Clean is My
Air? workshop run by Andrew from the Network for Clean Air. The workshop helped provide 12 people with the skills to undertake a 'citizen science' study of the air quality/ air pollution in their own neighbourhoods, how to plan the project, what equipment to use, how to create an air quality map and how to interpret the results.



The workshop participants learnt about the two air pollutants of most concern – microscopic airborne particles, known as 'PM10s' as well as nitrogen dioxide (NO2).

In most cities and urban areas, pollution from road traffic, and particularly diesel fumes, is the most significant cause of poor air quality.




